***TRANSITIONAL HOUSING WORKER***

**Overview of the Role:**

The Transitional Housing Worker (THW) supports individuals experiencing homelessness in Oxford County with securing permanent housing after being accepted into the OCCHC **transitional housing program**. The incumbent will work alongside individuals exiting the local emergency shelter system or experiencing precarious living situations to identify needs and goals for support, connect participants to alternative supports, and assist with transition and navigation of community resources, including access to permanent housing. The THW will help develop life skills needed to increase their quality of life. This is accomplished by building on the strengths and capacities of the participants through active engagement in person-centered wellness activities and SMART goal planning.

**Hours of Work:** 30 hours weekly - days per week & hours per day to be negotiated

**Requirements:**

- Completed post-secondary education in social services or related field and a current Member of a regulatory college, such as the Ontario College of Social Workers and Social Service Workers (OCSWSSW)
- Considerable experience addressing the needs of individuals and families experiencing homelessness or those at risk of homelessness including developing and implementing successful case management plans.
- Understanding of community agencies and a cross-section of service providers.
